Player starts off in a lab located in the junkyard

- "Spawns" around the recharge station.
- "Spawns" inside of a chamber that's sealed shut and hard to break in
 - The lock malfunctions (or TV head has enough energy to escape).

Crawlers

- New pop-up enemy that can attack/pop up from the ground(?).
- Lies dormant in the piles of dead robots
 - A zombie basically.
 - Will randomly spring to life at the sound of nearby robots.
- "A withered fragile bot with heightened perception capable of sensing whatever it can latch on to become stronger.

Haulers

- Big but slower
- Pick up walls/terrain and just drop it on the nearest entity.
- "Known for simplifying construction, haulers are able to transport and deposit exquisite materials from one site to another. Its enhanced durability and programming makes it difficult to be looted."
 - Needs more work

Bulldozers/Pusher

- Pushes the player(s) and terrain.
- "Known for cleaning construction sites, bulldozers/pushers can easily flatten terrain and buildings with ease. They are also known for causing mass destruction when utilized incorrectly."
 - Will update it later to be more reflective of how it's important to the bulldozers we see irl rn.

Enemy Scissorhands (Gardener Bot) LOP-R

- Slice plants
- Plants fertilizer
- Very fast enemy
- Al: Aims for the weakest enemy to kill and gain energy.
- "A popular bot well known for its versatility with its scissorhands. The bot is capable of gardening, butchering, and protecting their host at a speedy rate. It's now unknown why it was trendy to own one, but it wasn't a threat to society back then." (v1)
- "Once a trendy and friendly bot for having scissorhands,
 LOP-R excels in housework such as gardening and home defense. However, due to a software update from (name)
 Inc., they have become rather a bit harsh."

Flying Robot Enemies

- Crawling around (can't fly anymore)
